## **Reminders for Parents**

- Only nursery parents are allowed in the school playground. They should continue to enter via gate at the side of the school.
- Pupils will only be allowed to line up in the playground at the times above so should not arrive too
  early
- Parents must keep a 2 metre distance from each other if waiting outside the school building and should wear a face covering.
- Contact with the school office should continue to be by phone call, text message, email or by appointment only.

**Uniform** – It is recommended that your child wears clothing that can be washed frequently and blazers or any items which require dry cleaning should not be worn to school.

**School Bags** - We strongly encourage that school bags are not brought into school whenever possible. Snack, water bottle and packed lunch (if needed) are all that your child should need to bring in. No toys, books, balls or other items should be brought into school.

**Lunch Arrangements –** Lunches must be selected by **Wednesday 10th March** for next week. If no lunch is selected, your child will not receive a school lunch and must come with a packed lunch instead.

**After School Clubs and Breakfast Club –** CLASP, SociaBall Kids and Oscars Breakfast Club will begin again next week and have been in touch already with parents about this.

## Staff Testing

All school staff, including catering, janitorial and cleaning staff, will undertake lateral flow testing for COVID-19 twice a week starting next week.

I must express my gratitude to the parents and carers of our P1-P3 pupils for cooperating with these rules, ensuring a smooth, safe start back to school life.

Finally, thank you to all our parents and carers for supporting their children with this period of home learning. We do not underestimate how challenging this time has been for you.

We look forward to welcoming back our P4-P7 pupils on Monday.
