

P5 Home Learning Grid – Term 1 until October

Numeracy: Mental and Written Maths

- Revise the Times tables.
Make a poster, repeat out loud, find an app or game.
- Work on spelling numbers as words, challenge yourself, try 3, 4, 5, or 6 digits.



Beyond Number: Ideas of chance and uncertainty

- Investigate chance and uncertainty. Create your own experiment and predict the likely outcome.
- You could flip a coin 10 times and predict the likelihood of it landing face up 5 times.
- You could roll a dice 20 times. How many times does it land on a 6?



Numeracy: Online



- SumDog: Login and play, there will be challenges announced in class
- Practise mental addition and times tables with 'Hit the Button'

Literacy: Spelling

Literacy: Research/Science



- What interesting facts about space has been in the news lately? Could you find out some more? E.g. about the NASA Artemis mission or Mars Rover missions.
- Present you findings in any way you like and show the class.



Literacy: Reading

- Read as much as possible. Genre, length and difficulty are up to you, please make it part of your daily or weekly routine.
- Create a **book review** to share with the class. You could include: What is the title, who is the author? What kind of book is it? Fiction or Non-Fiction. What was your favourite part? What did you enjoy about this book? How many stars would you give it?



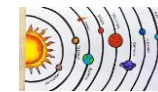
Social Studies: Space
