Literacy: Reading

Please make reading part of your weekly routine; Genre, length and difficulty are up to you. Create a **book review** to share with the class. You could include: What is the title, who is the author? What kind of book is it? What was your favourite part? What did you enjoy about this book?

Modern Languages: French

Revise your times tables – Try a poster, say them out loud or use a fun app or game.

Number words challenge – Practise spelling numbers as words. Try writing 3, 4, 5, 6 or even 7-digit numbers!

Literacy- Talking & Listening

It's time to take the spotlight! Write a short speech on a topic that's important to you—like the environment, fairness, children's rights or anything you care about. Make it powerful, make it personal and get ready to share it with the class. We can't wait to hear what you have to say!

HWB - Building Resilience

Create your own Memory Jar filled with items that are special to you. If you don't have a jar, a small box works just as well. Decorate it to show your personality. Add things like photos, drawings, tickets, or notes—anything that represents a favourite memory.

Literacy: Handwriting


