Tools for Writing (Grammar):



Find different openers in the books you are reading at home. Create a bank of your favourite openers. You could upload it on Teams so we can use it at our enable table.



Modern Languages: Spanish



Find a song or Christmas Carol sung in Spanish and learn it. Make sure you know the tune and you can share the translated lyrics with the class! You may want to perform it for the class or record it and upload it!



Numeracy – Decimal Diner

Create your own menu with at least 5 items and give each a decimal price (e.g. £2.59, £5.32).

- Choose 3 or 4 items to “order” and find the total cost.
- Work out how much change you would get from £10 or £20.



Literacy- Talking & Listening



Talk about something you're proud of this term and one goal you'd like to achieve next. Explain why you're proud and how you'll reach your goal.

Challenge: Ask a family member to share something they're proud of too.



HWB – Building Resilience

Everyone carries an invisible bucket that fills up whenever we do kind and helpful things for others. These are ‘bucket fillers’. When we say things that are mean, uncaring, or disrespectful, these acts are bucket dippers. Think about ways that you might make amends for dipping someone's bucket. Draw your own bucket and write your ideas inside.
