**Science:** Can you go on an outdoor scavenger hunt and make a list of the living and non living things you see? You could draw pictures to illustrate your list or make a map outlining the living and non living things on your doorstep.

**Maths:** Carry out a survey with your family and friends. You could explore their favourite colour, movie or flavour of ice cream. Can you present what you find through a tally chart? You could make up as many categories as you like.

**Numeracy:** Log into your Sumdog account and explore some games and numeracy challenges.

**Social Studies:** This term we will learn about caring for our environment. With an adult, can you create a poster of ways to care for our planet? Maybe you can encourage people to turn off taps, or pick up litter? What ways can you think of?
